LEVEL 3 - Database Skills for Data Source Creation, Tables, Etc.

Can do full system installations, including database connectivity and has networking knowledge.



LEVEL 2 - Operating System Proficiency, Including Creating Security Groups

Experience of basic photo ID software, can install components and provide basic training.



LEVEL 4 - Microsoft Certified Engineer (MCE)

All skills learned in other levels, plus the Systems Engineer has knowledge of high-end electromechanical systems.
