Secure Your Organization: Prepare for 2025–2026 Grant Cycles

This checklist helps organizations across industries assess their readiness to apply for federal and private security, cybersecurity, and safety funding.

<b>✓</b>	1.	Assess Your Current Security Setup
		Do you have security cameras, access control, or alarm systems in place?  Are there known safety concerns or incidents in your community or location?  Has your organization experienced threats, vandalism, or break-ins in the past?  Have you conducted a recent risk or vulnerability assessment?
	2.	Identify Eligible Projects
		Physical security enhancements (e.g., reinforced doors/windows, access control) Surveillance systems and lighting Cybersecurity and IT protection upgrades Emergency alert systems or panic buttons Safety-related planning, training, or communication tools
<b>^</b>	3.	Get Organizational Buy-In
		Do you have board or leadership approval to apply for security grants?  Can you dedicate staff or a point person to support the process?  Are you able to provide matching funds if required?
	4.	Prepare Documentation in Advance
		Have your organizational documents and EIN ready Obtain a recent site map or floor plan Draft a brief narrative about your safety concerns and proposed solutions Know your Unique Entity ID (UEI) and SAM.gov registration status (for federal grants)
